Pickin' Peaches

Shop at a farmer's market for the ripest and freshest peaches possible. Look for golden peaches without green traces near the stem.

Inspect peach's surface. The skin shouldn't be bruised in any way; it should have a soft, downy covering of white fuzz; and should be streaked with both pink and yellow.

Smell the peach to see if it is sweet scented.

Did you Know?

Texas harvests 23 million pounds of peaches annually from 4,000 to 6,000 acres in Hill and Gillespie counties, East Texas, and North and Central Texas. All production is for fresh market in-state sales.
